Within the Aspire2Work course you will have an opportunity to gain employability skills through participating in work experience.



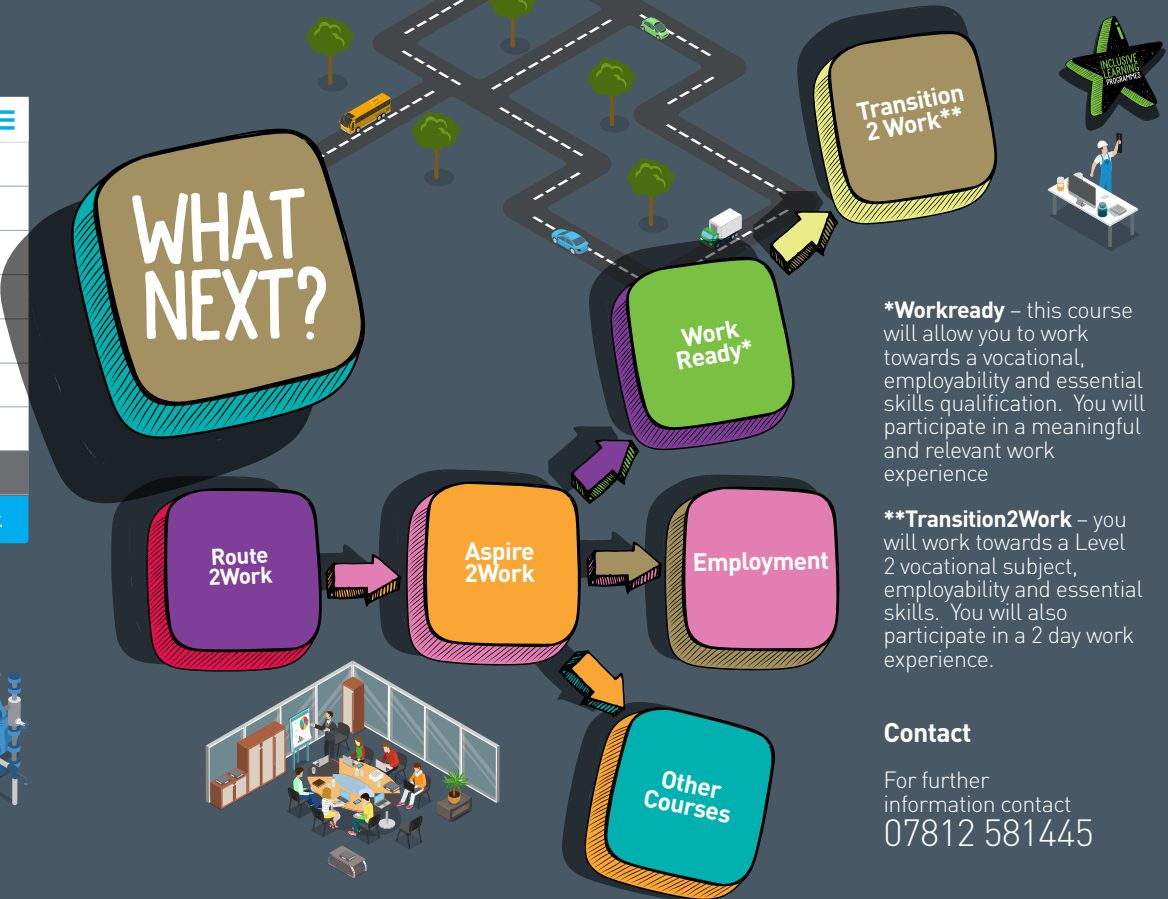
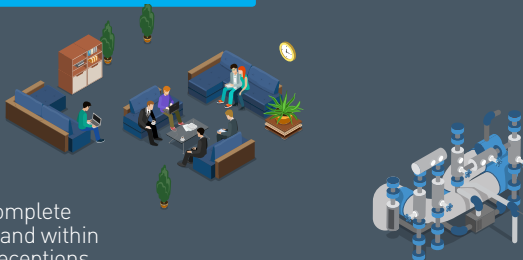

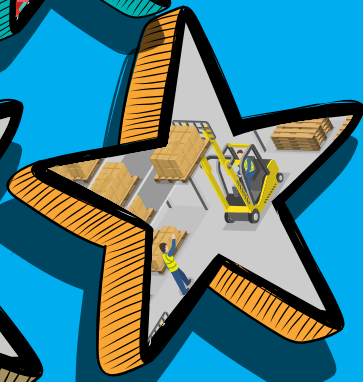
***Workready** – this course will allow you to work towards a vocational, employability and essential skills qualification. You will participate in a meaningful and relevant work experience
